



2007 FormulaCar Magazine FE Championship Series

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Purpose: The 2007 FormulaCar Magazine FE Championship Series will promote and publicize competition among FE owners/drivers. The series will provide season end trophies to the top ten in each Championship, significant event coverage in FormulaCar Magazine as well as a series page on www.eformulacarnews.com.

Series entry is automatic by entering the series races.

- a. Each entrant will automatically be entered into the Division / Championship where their official SCCA Region of Record is located.
- b. Each driver is requested to send 4 pictures, one of the driver (head shot), and 3 pics of the racecar (2 side views and 1 front view). The pictures must be emailed electronically (in jpeg format) to the addresses listed below.
- c. A driver bio is also requested to assist with event coverage.

These vehicles will be raced in compliance with the 2007 SCCA Club Racing GCR National FE Rules. SCCA Enterprises reserves the right, in its reasonable discretion, to amend or modify the Rules and Regulations for the 2007 FormulaCar Magazine FE Championship Series at any time via Tech Bulletins or Competitor Bulletins that will be posted on <http://www.eformulacarnews.com> and/or <http://www.sccaenterprises.com>. Updates requiring series decals may be made with appropriate timing and distribution information.

The 2007 FormulaCar Magazine FE Championship Series will be contested in 6 divisions, each with a Division Champion. The official events in each division are listed in the appendix. Each division will have six official races.

Points, for each race, will be earned based on the SCCA Points System (12, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1) places one thru nine. Places will be determined by the finishing position of FE racecars in the race from the Official Results (as per the 2007 GCR).

The Divisional Championship Points will be the addition of the best 6 races for each entered driver. All drivers may drop up to 2 in division races to include up to 2 out of division races; only from other official 2007 FormulaCar Magazine FE Championship Series events. The June Sprints (June 22-24) event at Road America will have a 50% points bonus (18, 14, 11, 9, 8, 6, 5, 3, 2) that can count in the "in division" (for CENDiv/GLDiv) or "out of division" totals for the competitor.

Ties for 1st Place in the Division Points Championship will be decided by the number of first place finishes; then if necessary, the number of second place finishes, etc.

The top 10 drivers in each Division will receive awards at the Official SCCA Enterprises FE Championship event at Road Atlanta (the ARRC), November 9th – 11th (race on Sunday the 11th).

It will be the responsibility of the driver/owner to:

NOTE: MAZDASPEED Motorsports Development has committed to a Divisional and Enterprises Champion prize fund; details to follow. Payment will be direct from MAZDASPEED with SCCA Enterprises coordinating the points and payout eligibility. Total of all Divisional and Enterprises Champion amounts will be approximately \$15,000.

To be eligible for payment decal placement on all cars must comply with Mazdaspeed standard decal placement for open wheels cars (by June 1, 2007). Decals can be obtained directly from Mazdaspeed.
